Success for Students with ADHD (K-6)

About the course

This half-day session is broken into three main components:

1. Happy and Connected: Ensuring the Wellbeing of Students with ADHD -A look at the research and strategies to help these vulnerable children manage their behaviour, increase self-esteem and build social connections.
2. Partnering with Parents - Parents of ADHD children may have had negative experiences with the school system in the past. Additionally, ADHD can run in families and there may be more than one family member living with the condition. We will explore parents' perspectives and provide strategies to build positive, constructive relationships.
3. High Impact Teaching Strategies for Primary-Aged Students with ADHD

Equity means every student getting what they need, rather than every student getting the same.

ADHD students need environmental, instructional and academic adjustments in order to reach their potential.

Strategies to manage behaviour, build social connections, enhance self-esteem and increase organisational skills will be discussed in this interactive session.
