Violence at Work: Skilled up and Safe Bunbury Area Trial Event:

About the course

This skills based program is suitable for any person working in an education environment. You will learn valuable skills that will ensure you have the confidence to keep you and your students safe in the event of a verbal or physical encounter while at work. This course has been specifically designed to give you the tools needed to deal with a wide range of incidents that may occur in an education setting.

Day One will explore Department of Education Guidelines around violence in schools as well as the SSTUWA position. It will also focus on building the skills and knowledge required to keep yourself safe in the workplace.

Day Two will be scenario based and will involve opportunities to apply and practice the skills in soft, medium and high-end situations that may occur in the school context.
