# Instructional Intelligence Information Session

## Find out more about training a team of Instructional Intelligence Facilitators for your school

#### Wednesday 12 June 2019

Commencing September 2019, the SSTUWA is proud to offer another opportunity for schools to train a team of at least two Instructional Intelligence Facilitators. Over 270 educators from 70 different schools have previously participated in the 10 day course and are reaping the benefits of having an onsite team of Facilitators to share professional learning and ongoing support with other teachers.

The 'train the trainer' event will be spaced over two years and will be presented by **Professor Barrie** Bennett from Canada. 60 hours of professional learning will be provided and will centre on what instructionally intelligent teachers do to support learning in classrooms.

A range of interrelated topics that support effective teaching and learning will be covered over the 60 hours. The topics will be introduced as a gradual shift from the least complex (not necessarily least important) to the most complex and powerful. Each area is designed to help facilitate the idea of the teacher as a reflective, analytical, creative practitioner.
