The national winner will win an additional \$5,000, while the national runner-up will also receive an added \$1,000 prize.

Last year's winner came from Western Australia, with North Metropolitan TAFE student Samin Zare taking out the award with her entry Enjoyable Time (pictured above with her winning photo).
